### **Early College Opportunities**

### Middle College Program

• Allow students to complete an associate degree or college certificate in full while still in high school. These programs are extremely rigorous, with a competitive admissions process, and requires a three-year commitment from student. Program begins in grade 11 and students continue in the program for 3 years, adding one more year of high school.

#### **Dual Enrollment**

• Dual enrollment courses are traditional college classes usually held on an LMC campus but are sometimes offered at a high school or tech center.

#### **Direct Credit**

• These classes are taught by college credentialed teachers at a student's high school or tech center during the regular school day. The student receives both high school and college credit for these courses.

## Michigan Transfer Agreement

- Designed to facilitate transfer from community colleges to baccalaureate colleges and universities
- Provides transferability of 30 semester credits to meet many (and in some cases all) of the General Education Requirements at participating four-year schools in Michigan
- Visit michigantransfernetwork.org for more information
- Minimum of 30 semester hours of coursework
  - English/Communications 6 credits
  - Mathematics 4 credits
  - Natural Sciences 8 credits
  - Social Sciences 6 credits
  - Humanities 6 credits

- Any of the following:
  - SAT Scores (if you've taken the SAT)
    - English: 27 Math: 23 Reading: 26
- LMC Accuplacer Scores (if you haven't taken the SAT)

  - WritePlacer: 5
  - Next Generation Math: 230
- High School GPA incoming Sophomores 2.5 or higher meet English and Reading
